

Registration Tips

General Tips

- DO NOT HIT THE “BACK” BUTTON AT ANY TIME DURING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS. You will have the opportunity to “save and exit” at various times during the process. You may edit any field before finalizing your information. You will see an edit option on your final screen.
- All fields must be completed. If you do not have a fax, you can leave the field blank.
- School enrollment is available on the WIAA website at: <http://wiaawi.org/directory.php> **PLEASE DO NOT “guess” at your enrollment.**
- You are responsible for entering in the correct number of team members competing. If an individual athlete competes in more than one event (i.e. a solo and a stunt group or a dance trio) they must pay for both events.
- You will have a chance to review all information and make any necessary changes at the end of your registration. Please review your data for accuracy.
- Please print out your final confirmation, include **check or money order to Center Stage, LLC** and mail to **Julie Fullerton** at the PO box listed.

Cheer Teams

- When selecting “Main Category,” please remember that school/rec cheer teams **MUST** follow all National Federation rules. All Star cheer teams will follow USAF guidelines.
- Small varsity teams are 12 or less, large are 13 or more.
- CoEd teams will be asked to include the number of males. If entries warrant, we will divide the division based on size/number of males.
- All Star teams: If you are unclear of you team’s age category, please refer to the USAF guidelines at: <http://www.usasf.net/safety/cheerrules/>. Remember: **ALL** of your team members must be at or below the age limit.
- When registering soloists, please list their first **AND** last names. When registering a stunt team, please list last names only.

Dance Teams

- If you are a dance team and are not directly affiliated with a school or rec program, you **MUST** register for the **All Star** category. Please be aware of the **age limits** for the various divisions (see below, also listed on *General Information* page.) You will then be asked to calculate the average grade level of your team. If there are enough teams, All Star and school teams will be separated. If not, they will share the category(s).
ALL STAR DANCE DIVISIONS:
 - Tiny: Average grade level of Kindergarten or younger
 - Mini: Average grade level of 3.0 or younger
 - Youth: Average grade level of 6.0 or younger
 - Junior: Average grade level of 9.0 or younger
 - Senior: Average grade level of 12.0 or younger
- Collegiate: Should enter Collegiate school division
- You may enter as many categories as you wish, but we **CANNOT** guarantee more than a 20-minute interval between your performances. We do our best to set the minimum interval at 10 routines, or 30 minutes, but this may not always be possible.
- The “Open” category is available for any style of dance not already listed. The division will not be divided further. **PLEASE INDICATE THE STYLE OF YOUR ROUTINE IN THE “COMMENTS” SECTION**
- Solos/duets/trios/ensembles are ANY style. Each individual can compete in the division only once. (i.e. one solo and one duet, not a jazz solo and a hip hop solo.)
- Solos/duets/trios/ensembles will be divided by age/grade as entries warrant.
- When registering soloists, please list their first **AND** last names. When registering duets/trios/ensembles team, please list last names only.

DANCE SOLO/ENSEMBLE AWARDS:

ALL solo, duet, trio and ensemble awards will take place in the auxiliary performance area (where the solo/ensemble contest is held) immediately following tabulation of the session results. Awards will be given for the top three scoring individuals/groups. Awards will be extend to the five highest scores if entries warrant. **HOWEVER: ALL dancers in grades 8 and younger will receive a medal.** Those individuals/groups who do not place in the award position will be called to the awards table by name **IN NO PARTICULAR ORDER** to receive a medal and scoresheet.

PLEASE NOTE: NO score sheets and/or awards will be mailed. (Team or individual/ensemble.)
